Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that the antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come. This is how we know it is the last hour.

1 John 2:22

Who is the liar? It is the man who denies that Jesus is the Christ. Such a man is the antichrist—he denies the Father and the Son.

1 John 4:3

but every spirit that does not acknowledge Jesus is not from God. This is the spirit of the antichrist, which you have heard is coming and even now is already in the world.

2 John 1:7

Many deceivers, who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh, have gone out into the world. Any such person is the deceiver and the antichrist.

And these passages, especially the first, refer to antichrists from John's time.

Moreover, according to John, in saying "even now many antichrists have come. This is how we know it is the last hour" and "even now is already in the world." the endtimes should have occurred 2000 years ago.

"Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, **All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.**"

Even if Satan were to have a kingdom that kingdom would be under the jurisdiction of the King of kings Jesus Christ, because all power has been given to the Son, " That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth." Philippians 2:10.

I have a bigger problem with christians being intimidated by satan "having a kingdom". Of course he has a kingdom. The world is in the sway of the evil one.

However, satan is, and always will be a puppet in the hands of God. His punishment for rebellion is the same as ours: Being given over to our lusts. Satan has a kingdom, however satan is under Christ's dominion, therefore satan's kingdom is a "subsidiary of God's kingdom", scheduled for disposal on Judgement Day.

By the way, the purpose for the analogy was to compare the hand with God, and the glove with satan.

Again, no need to be intimidated, by satan having a kingdom. Just allow him to think he's in control. After all, there is a funny side to him leading us into sin, so that we can repent (ie. the joke is on him).
